- (01) HOUSE WINE MARCEL HUBERT, FRANCE
£2.95 (Glass) £9.95 (Bottle)
medium dry. this is a soft, medium dry wine with a fresh lively finish
- (02) 2008 CATARRATTO/INZOLIA £12.95, borgo selene, sicilia, Italy
a fruity and crisp wine from sunny sicily.
- (03) 2008 MACABEO DO YECLA £14.95, molino loco, levante, Spain
tangy and crisp, this is a zesty white wine from a traditional spanish grape variety.
- (04) 2008 PIEMONTE CORTESE £15.95, cà del matt, piemonte, Italy
gavi by another name, this is a classic white from northern italy.
- (05) 2009 SEMILLON/CHARDONNAY £16.95, calbuco, central valley, Chile, this wine has new world ripeness but is still dry and crisp.
- (06) 2008 SOAVE CLASSICO £16.95, cantina di monteforte, veneto, Italy
a lovely fresh soave, an excellent match for lighter dishes.
- (07) 2009 `GOATS DO ROAM` WHITE £17.95, goats do roam, paarl, South Africa
full-bodied and rich with flavours of peach.
- (08) 2008 DARLING CHENIN BLANC £19.95, fairview, paarl, South Africa,
this wine has flavours of ripe apples and a crisp, clean finish.
- (09) 2008 PINOT GRIGIO GRAVE DEL FRIULI £20.95, ponte del diavolo, fruli-venezia-giulia, Italy
a very crisp and fresh pinot grigio.
- (10) 2008 FIANO/GRECO £21.95, a mano, southern italy, Italy
zingy fruit and floral flavours from puglia.
- (11) 2008 CÔTES DU RHÔNE BLANC `PARALLÈLE 45` £23.95, paul jaboulet aîné, rhône, france,
rich flavours but classically balanced, a great food wine.
- (12) 2008 SAUVIGNON BLANC £24.95, omrah, western Australia, Australia
a cool-climate sauvignon, restrained and food-friendly.
- (13) 2008 MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC £28.95, yealands estate, marlborough, New Zealand
crisp and clean sauvignon blanc from one of new zealand's best regions.
- (14) 2008 SANCERRE, DOMAINE SAUTEREAU £32.95, loire, France
classic, elegant old-world sauvignon blanc.
- (15) 2004 MEURSAULT `LE LIMOZIN` £46.95, jean claude boisset
a wonderfully elegant meursault with intense, creamy stone fruit flavours,
fine balancing acidity and delicately handled oak ageing. a classy wine of great finesse

ROSE WINES

- (31) 2008 `R` ROSATO, ALPHA ZETA £15.95, Veneto, Italy
Juicy and crisp with fresh raspberry and redcurrant flavours and a medium finish.
- (32) 2008 `LE PETIT JABOULET` GRENACHE ROSÉ £19.95, Vin de Pays
Portes de Méditerranée, Paul Jaboulet Aîné, Rhône, France
Classic dry, crisp Rhone rose with delicious light red berry fruit.
- (33) 2008 SYRAH/PETIT VERDOT ROSÉ SELECCIÓN £24.95, Viña Chocalan,
Maipo Valley, Chile, Deep in colour, this is a richer, full-bodied rose
with dark fruit flavours and touch of spice on the finish.

DESSERT WINES

- (34) 2008 `LA BERYL BLANC` Fairview, Paarl, South Africa
£3.95 (Glass) £21.95 (Bottle)
A Chenin Blanc dessert wine, sweet and delicious but still light and clean.

RED WINES

- (16) HOUSE WINE MARCEL HUBERT, FRANCE
£2.95 (Glass) £9.95 (Bottle)
a hearty wine, mellow and rounded with lots of plummy fruit and southern warmth, soft enough to drink on its own
- (17) 2008 NERELLO MASCALESE/NERO D`AVOLA £12.95, Borgo Selene,
Sicilia, Italy, a juicy, medium-bodied wine from Sicily.
- (18) 2007 CARIGNAN, VIN DE PAYS DE L`HÉRAULT £15.95, Domaine La Croix
Gratiot, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, a traditional French variety
with plenty of flavour and character
- (19) 2008 BARDOLINO `PAGUS` £18.95, Cortegiara, Veneto, Italy
a very elegant, medium-bodied wine with classic north-Italian acid ity.
- (20) 2006 `HÉCULA` MONASTRELL DO YECLA £19.95, Bodegas Castaño,
Levante, Spain, rich and warm with deep fruit flavours from the Spanish climate.
- (21) 2008 MERLOT, CALBUCO £19.95, Central Valley, Chile
a smooth, fruity medium-bodied Merlot.
- (22) 2008 CARMENÈRE SELECCIÓN £20.95, Viña Chocalan, Maipo Valley,
Chile, deep and dark fruit with a good savoury balance, excellent with red meat.
- (23) 2006 MCLAREN VALE SHIRAZ/VOIGNIER £21.95, Willunga 100, South
Australia, australia, a rich, juicy Shiraz, with a little lifted note from the
Viognier.
- (24) 2008 CHIANTI, CANTINE LEONARDO DA VINCI £22.95, Tuscany, Italy,
unoaked, this Chianti is modern and filled with fresh, crunchy fruit.
- (25) 2008 `PUNTO FINAL` MENDOZA MALBEC CLASICO £22.95, Bodega Renacer,
Mendoza, Argentina, Argentina's speciality, an intense, deep blackcurrant wine.
- (26) 2007 CÔTES DU RHÔNE ROUGE `PARALLÈLE 45` £24.95, Paul Jaboulet Aîné,
Rhône, France, good red berry fruit with the savoury and herbal notes that
come from classic Cotes du Rhone.
- (27) 2008 RIOJA, SALBIDE £26.95, Rioja & Calatayud, Spain
a big, spicy Rioja, great with any meat dishes.
- (28) 2008 BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR `LES URSULINES` £33.95, Jean-Claude Boisset,
Burgundy, France elegant and silky, this is refined and superb red Burgundy.
- (29) 2006 PALAZZO DELLA TORRE £36.95, Allegrini, Veneto, Italy
rich and intense, a deeply-flavoured wine from one of Northern Italy's
best producers.
- (30) 2001 CHATEAU LA LAGUNE £64.95, medoc, bordeaux
consistently fine and drinkable Bordeaux with rich fleshy fruit flavours
and elegant, supporting savoury tannins.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

- (35) 2009 PINK MOSCATO £10.95, Innocent Bystander, Victoria, Australia,
fun and delicious, this off-dry wine is the perfect aperitif or light desert wine.
- (36) NV ROSATO SPUMANTE £22.95, Ca` Morlin, Veneto, Italy
Light red fruit flavours in this fresh sparkling wine from Northern Italy.
- (37) NV BRUT, VALENTIN BIANCHI £24.95, Mendoza, Argentina
Lively bubbles and full, ripe fruit flavours.
- (38) NV `PERLE NOIRE` BLANC DE NOIRS BRUT £29.95, Louis Bouillot,
Burgundy, France, Made in the traditional champagne style just further south
in Burgundy,
- (39) NV CUVÉE SPÉCIALE BRUT £39.95, Edouard Brun, Champagne, France,
a very classic champagne, a toasty nose with crisp fruit on the palate.
- (40) NV `D DE DEVAUX` LA CUVÉE £54.95, Devaux, Champagne, France,
Devaux's premium Cuvee, selected from only the best grapes is a particularly
elegant mouthful.
- (41) NV BRUT PREMIER, LOUIS ROEDERER £64.95, Champagne, France,
possibly the best Grande Marque, Roederer's NV Brut is complex and
delicious with good crisp fruit
